Annexations: Part of Etha township annexed by Reynoldsburg village, Part of Granville township annexed by Granville village, Part of Hanover township annexed by Hanover village, Parts of Lima and Harrison township annexed by Pataskala village, Parts of Madison and Newark townships annexed by Newark city, Part of Monroe township annexed by Johnstown village, Part of Union township annexed by Hebron village

Additional Annexations: None

Other: Heath village changed to city, Heath city made coextensive with Johnny Clem township

1970 to 1980²

Annexations: Parts of Licking and Union townships annexed to Heath city, Parts of Granville, Madison, Newark and Newton townships annexed to Newark city, Part of Harrison township annexed by Pataskala village,

Additional Annexations: by Reynoldsburg and Granville, Hanover, Kirkersville, Johnstown & Utica villages

Other: Boundaries between Licking County and Fairfield & Perry Counties were revised, area detached by Hanover village

1980 to 1990³

Annexations: by Heath city from Union township, Newark city from Granville, Madison & Newark townships, Pataskala village from Harrison township

Additional Annexations: by Reynoldsburg city and Alexandria, Granville, Gratiot and Johnstown villages

Other: Buckeye Lake village incorporated

1990 to 1998⁴
