TOWNSHIP ANNEXATIONS AND REVISIONS, 1960 TO 1998

It should be noted that when comparing township level population data from various years, data reflect annexations and boundary changes within the townships. A complete list of township level changes is included below.

1960 to 1970¹

Annexations: Ely township organized from parts of Carlisle and Elyria townships, Parts of Amherst township annexed by Amherst city & Elyria city (coextensive with Ely township), Parts of Brownhelm, Charleston & Sheffield townships annexed by Lorain city, Part of Russia township annexed by Oberlin city

Additional Annexations: None

Other: Avon, Avon Lake, North Ridgeville Vermillion and Amherst villages changed to cities, Vermilion-on-the-Lake city dis-incorporated and annexed by Vermilion city

1970 to 1980²

Annexations: Parts of Amherst, Carlisle, Eaton & Elyria townships annexed to Elyria city, Parts of Amherst, Elyria and Sheffield townships annexed to Lorain city

Additional Annexations: by Vermilion & Oberlin cities and South Amherst, Grafton, Lagrange & Wellington villages

Other: None

1980 to 1990³

Annexations: by Amherst city from Amherst township and Lorain city, by Elyria city from Amherst, Carlisle & Elyria townships, by Lorain city from Elyria & Sheffield townships

Additional Annexations: Grafton village, Lagrange village, Oberlin city and Wellington village

Other: None

1990 to 1998⁴

Annexations: New Russia township, new township formed from that portion of Russia township outside of Oberlin city; includes part of South Amherst village, Russia township area reduced by formation of New Russia township from part of Russia township outside of Oberlin city
