

APPENDIX A:

SUMMIT COUNTY, OHIO

TOWNSHIP ANNEXATIONS AND REVISIONS, 1960 TO 1998

It should be noted that when comparing township level population data from various years, data reflect annexations and boundary changes within the townships. A complete list of township level changes is included below.

1960 to 1970¹

Annexations: Parts of Franklin township annexed by Clinton village and Barberton city, Fairlawn village incorporated from part of Copley township, Part of Hudson township annexed by Hudson village, Part of Northampton township annexed by Akron city

Additional Annexations: None

Other: Macedonia village incorporated and made coextensive with Macedonia township, Norton city incorporated from Norton township, Richfield village incorporated from part of Richfield township, Stow village changed to city since 1960

1970 to 1980²

Annexations: Parts of Bath, Copley, Coventry, Northampton and Springfield townships were annexed to Akron city, Part of Coventry township annexed to Barberton city, Part of Northampton township annexed to Cuyahoga Falls city, Parts of Springfield township were annexed to Lakemore and Mogadore villages, Parts of Twinsburg township were annexed to Macedonia and Twinsburg cities

Additional Annexations: by Hudson village

Other: area was transferred from Northampton township to Akron city

1980 to 1990³

Annexations: Part of Northampton township annexed by Akron city, Akron city annexed from Bath, Copley, Northampton and Springfield townships, Barberton city annexed from Coventry township, Fairlawn city annexed from Bath and Copley townships, Lakemore village annexed from Springfield township, Macedonia city annexed from Twinsburg city, Northfield village annexed from Sagamore Hills township, Twinsburg township annexed from Twinsburg township

Additional Annexations: by Hudson village and Richfield village

Other: Green village incorporated, remainder of Northampton township merged into Cuyahoga Falls city
