It should be noted that when comparing township level population data from various years, data reflect annexations and boundary changes within the townships. A complete list of township level changes is included below.

1960 to 1970¹

Annexations: Parts of Fowler township annexed by Cortland village, Parts of Weatherfield and Howland townships annexed by Niles city, Parts of Howland and Warren townships annexed by Warren city, Parts of Hubbard township annexed to Hubbard city, Part of Liberty township annexed by Girard city, Newton Falls township annexed Newton Falls city

Additional Annexations: None

Other: Hubbard village changed to a city since 1960

1970 to 1980²

Annexations: Parts of Howland and Warren townships were annexed to Warren city

Additional Annexations: by Cortland village and Niles, Girard, and Newton Falls cities

Other: Lordstown village was incorporated in and subsequently annexed the balance of Lordstown township

1980 to 1990³

Annexations: by Cortland city from Bazetta, Fowler, Johnston and Mecca townships, by Warren city from Howland & Warren townships

Additional Annexations: by Girard city, Newton Falls city and Niles city

Other: Masury CDP deleted
