Annexations: Part of Baughman township annexed by Marshallville village, Parts of Baughman and Green townships annexed by Orrville city, Parts of Chippewa township annexed by Doylestown village, Parts of Milton and Chippewa annexed by Rittman city, Part of Congress township annexed by West Salem village, Parts of Wayne and Wooster townships annexed by Wooster city, Part of Sugar Creek township annexed by Dalton village

Annexations: Parts of Wayne and Wooster townships annexed to Wooster city

Annexations: Norton city annexed into Wayne County (from Chippewa township), by Wooster city from Wayne and Wooster townships
