





OHIO FARM INCOME

Cash receipts during 2001, from Ohio's livestock, livestock products, and crops totaled \$4.68 billion, 7.1 percent above last year's \$4.37 billion. Cash receipts from all crops in 2001 were up 7.7 percent from 2000. Cash receipts from livestock in 2001 were 6.2 percent above the 2000 cash receipts from livestock.

The 2001 value of cash receipts for crops, at \$2.82 billion, 7.7 percent above last year, was 16.4 percent below the record high \$3.37 billion in 1997. The percentage of total farm marketings attributable to crops in 2001 was 60.2 percent, up three tenths of one percent from the revised 2000 data.

The 2001 cash receipts for livestock and livestock products totaled \$1.86 billion, up 6.2 percent from last year but 4.9 percent below the record set in 1996. The percentage of total farm marketings earned by livestock and livestock products was 39.8 percent, down three tenths of one percent from the revised 2000 cash receipts.

Government payments totaled \$681.7 million, about half of one percent above last year's 678.1 million. This represents 12.7 percent of total cash receipts including government payments and 65.0 percent of net farm income after inventory adjustments, compared to 61.4 percent in 2000.

Agriculture in Ohio made a net value added contribution of \$2.26 billion to the National economy in 2001, up slightly from 2000. The final agricultural sector output, at \$5.48 billion, was up 1.1 percent from 2000. Intermediate consumption outlays totaled \$2.89 billion, up 1.6 percent from last year. Capital consumption at \$800.0 million was up slightly from 2000, while payments to stake holders at \$1.21 billion were up 5.8 percent.

The top five commodities in terms of cash receipts earned were **soybeans** with \$863.9 million and 18.5 percent of total receipts; **corn** with \$823.9 million and 17.6 percent of total receipts; **wholesale milk** with \$652.7 million and 13.9 percent of total receipts; **greenhouse and nursery** with \$568.1 million and 12.1 percent of total receipts; and **poultry and eggs** with \$469.7 million and 10.0 percent of total cash receipts. The commodities ranked sixth through tenth were hogs, cattle and calves, vegetables, wheat and hay, respectively. The top ten commodities accounted for 95.6 percent of all Ohio cash receipts.

The following ten counties ranked first through tenth, respectively, based on total cash receipts: Mercer, Darke, Wayne, Licking, Holmes, Putnam, Hardin, Lorain, Union and Lake. Wayne county ranked first in milk, cattle and calves and oats and hay. Mercer county ranked first in cash receipts for hogs, poultry and other livestock. Darke county was in first place for corn and soybeans. Wood county was first for wheat, and Lake county ranked number one for other crops.

This year's report includes publication of revised data by county for 2000 in addition to the 2001 preliminary data. The publication of the revised 2000 data by county permits a better comparison of the two years after the revisions have been made to reflect more complete data.

2001 OHIO FARM CASH RECEIPTS FROM TABLE II DATA



GROSS AND NET FARM INCOME, OHIO



PROCEDURE

Estimates of cash receipts from Ohio farm marketings were published initially in 1927 and annually since 1929. These county estimates of cash receipts for 2001 are published by the Department of Agricultural, Environmental and Development Economics of the Ohio State University's College of Food, Agricultural, and Environmental Sciences and the Ohio Agricultural Research and Development Center in cooperation with the National Agricultural Statistics Service of the United States Department of Agriculture. This bulletin contains 2001 Ohio county and state cash receipts estimates, and revised 1998-2000 state estimates. Also included are revised 2000 county and state cash receipts estimates to reflect the changes in county data from the preliminary estimates published in 2001. County production and inventory estimates of various commodities are published annually in the Ohio Agricultural Statistics bulletin.

Current cash receipts from farm marketings of farm products represent calendar year gross receipts from commercial market sales as well as loans (net of redemptions) made or guaranteed by CCC and purchases under price support programs. The value of home consumption and production expenses is excluded. County estimates of cash receipts from farm marketings are derived by allocating state estimates to counties on the basis of crop and livestock production and Census marketings by Agricultural Statistics Districts. Check data such as county dairy production from the milk market administrators are also used.


The definition of a farm includes a place which has annual sales of agricultural products of \$1,000 or more. This definition has been used since the 1974 Census of Agriculture. The average cash receipts per farm will aid in the comparison of counties with similar farm practices better than a comparison of total cash receipts.

This bulletin has been prepared through the efforts of many people, including personnel of agricultural agencies throughout Ohio. The greatest recognition is due to the large number of Ohio farmers and agri-businessmen for their interest and help in providing the basic data used in compiling this information.


